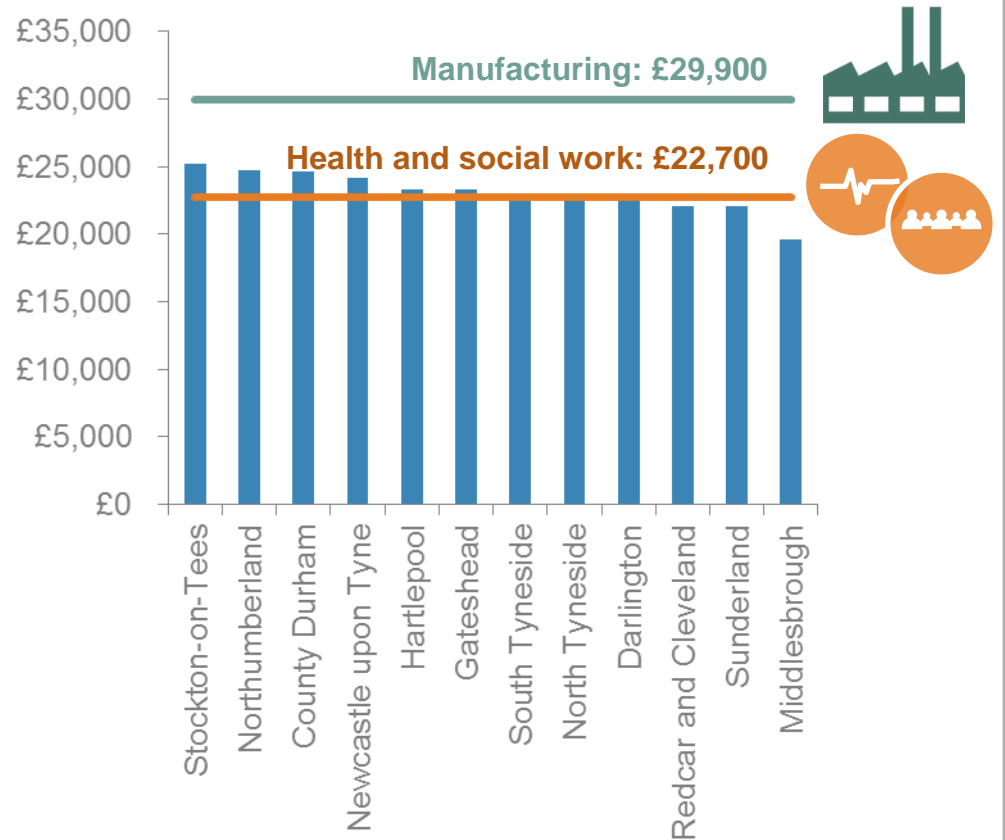
Key findings

- Average North East pay is rising faster than the national average
- Growing pay gap between men and women
- Manufacturing pay up sharply, while health and social work pay has fallen
